

Laser Tattoo Removal Post Treatment Skin Care Instructions

You have been treated with the Q-switch Yag laser ND-TT10. The treated area is very delicate and should be treated gently. An immediate post treatment application of an antibiotic cream will be applied to the treated area. To prevent any complications, please follow these instructions:

- Keep the site moist with an antibiotic cream Bactroban cream (available from your doctor) Until the irritation subsides (generally 3-4 days.) You may also use Polysporin BLUE original only. NO ZINC (this will cause your tattoo to change and stain the skin)

Do not let the area dry out or scab. This is especially important during the first 48 hours.

You may shower, but do not scrub the area until completely healed. Avoid scratching the area during the healing process

You may feel discomfort for 48 hours after your treatment. You may need a non-aspirin pain medication.

The skin should heal normally in 14-20 days. Contact us immediately should you have any concerns. 902-789-7266

The Tattoo will look foggy, and begin its fading process over the next month. Fading is typically 15-25% with each treatment. The total fading process can take up to 8-16 Weeks. Green and yellow inks fade more slowly and may take longer to achieve maximum fading.
